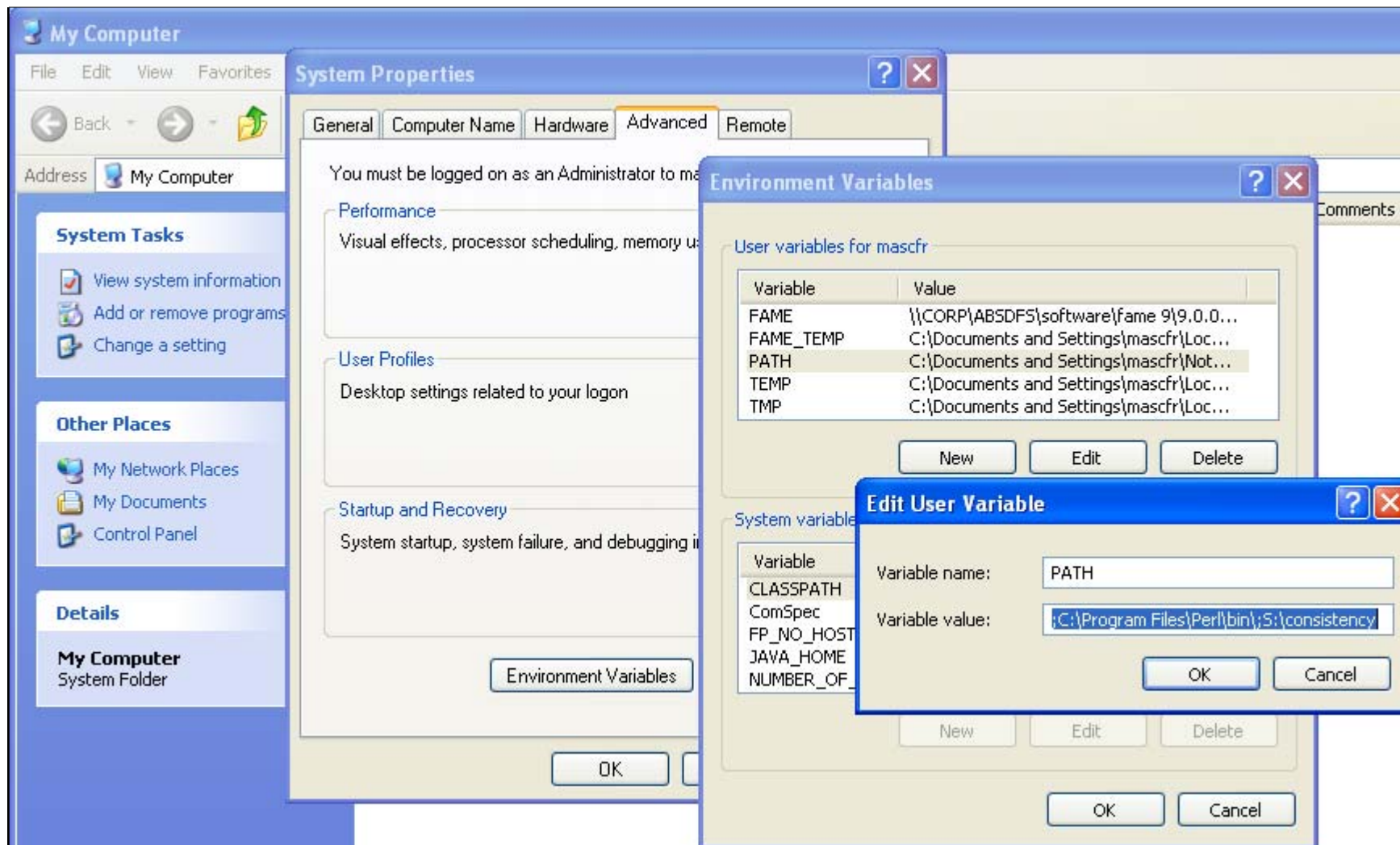


You can execute "consistency.pl" from any directory on your desktop without the need to physically copy this file into your local working directory each time. This will give me (Frank M) greater flexibility when making changes since it obviates the need for me to tell everyone to update their old version with a new one.

Go to start menu

- > My Computer
- > View system information
- > Advanced tab
- > Environment Variables
- > select "PATH" from list
- > Edit (button just below it)
- > append the string ";S:\consistency" as shown below (omit quotation marks)
- > OK
- > OK every other open window and close 'My Computer' window.

And you're set! Now there's never a need to copy over "consistency.pl" into your working directory. Just type it on the DOS command prompt.



**Note that the directions above are only for people who use the standard windows XP folder views. The slower way to perform the steps below (under the alternate folder views) is to open up the start menu and:**

- > **settings**
- > **control panel**
- > **system**
- > **advanced.**
